Literacy and Numeracy

PECS and Makaton are used to add to language and comprehension communication skills. Using these systems assists your child to develop language and oracy and reduce frustration.

Proloquo2go is a similar system to PECS that enables communication with i pads.



Interactive Diaries are used by the majority of our pupils as a means of communication with

parents and, is also a means of developing grasp of language and, where it is appropriate to enable answering questions.



Write from the Start is a unique programme to develop fine motor skills that is required before learning to write.

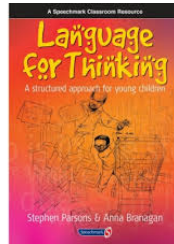


Literacy and Numeracy



Headsprout is an on-line Reading Program that develops reading skills through learning

structured reading. Headsprout reading develops an understanding of the text. That they have read.



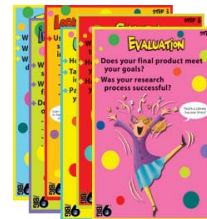
Language for Thinking is a resource that develops verbal language listening and comprehension skills or a text read by them.



An intervention scheme for learners in the primary and secondary schools that have difficulty to read and understand. 'Dyfal Donc' is a Welsh version of Catch Up.



'Big 6' - This is the name given to a series of daily exercises that assist our pupils to develop fine and concise skills especially to improve their active and literacy skills.

This is a means of targeting and monitoring key concepts. It can be used to learn many different tasks across the curriculum.

(Precision Teaching) focusses on where the child experiences difficulty e.g reading numbers. It targets the weakness and teaches, builds, monitors and evaluates to improve their learning.

(Active Support)

A programme that measures progress in personal skills working towards independence. Every child who works on Active Support have their individualized plan within the school.



Kumon is a series of books that build on specific numeracy and literacy skills in a series of lower case letter steps.

NUMICON is a multi-sensory method, that provides a visible and tactile method of understanding a numeracy concept.



Tric a Chlic— a series of books to teach children to read.
